NK® Brand Soybeans Available for 2008:

S00-H7 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready[®] Relative Maturity: 00-7

- ♦ High-yielding with strong iron deficiency chlorosis (IDC) tolerance plus *Phytophthora* root rot (PRR) field tolerance with the Rps1c gene
- ♦ This true medium-bush plant type is suited to 30" and narrower rows with excellent standability

S06-W2 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready Relative Maturity: 0-6

- ♦ Above-average PRR field and IDC tolerance with excellent brown stem rot (BSR) tolerance
- Well-adapted for Western areas, this medium-tall, rugged plant has excellent standability and good stress tolerance

S14-C5 Brand Added Traits: Roundup Ready and SCN Relative Maturity: I-4

- Very good IDC tolerance with good soybean cyst nematode (SCN) resistance and excellent BSR tolerance
- ♦ Equipped with Rps1k PRR protection, this medium-height plant is adapted to all row widths and performs well in poorly drained soils

S17-B5 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready Relative Maturity: I-7

- ♦ Top-yielding with above-average defensive ratings in all categories
- This medium-tall plant is widely adapted for its maturity zone with excellent standability and best performance in 30" and narrower rows

S20-P3 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready Relative Maturity: II-0

- Superior white mold tolerance, excellent BSR tolerance and above average PRR field tolerance with the Rps3a gene
- Moves well central to east within maturity zone and is best suited to soils where IDC is not a concern

- ◆ Top-notch pest and disease package features excellent IDC tolerance, race 3 SCN protection, above-average white mold tolerance, excellent BSR tolerance and very good PRR field tolerance with Rps1c gene

- Excellent yields, industry-leading SDS tolerance, Race 3 SCN protection and excellent PRR field tolerance

- Rugged, high-yielding variety with Race 3 SCN protection and above-average SDS and PRR field tolerance
- This tall-medium plant is ideal for stress-prone soils and has good standability

- Race 3 and 14 SCN resistance with excellent PRR field tolerance and very good SDS tolerance
- This fast-emerging soybean also provides good stress tolerance

S01-C9 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready Relative Maturity: 0-1

- ♦ Industry leader in IDC tolerance and very good PRR field tolerance with the Rps1k gene
- ♦ This medium-tall, medium-bush plant is adapted to 30" and narrower rows with excellent standability

S10-K1 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready Relative Maturity: I-0

- High-yielding with good IDC and white mold tolerance, plus very good PRR field tolerance and BSR tolerance
- This rugged variety is well-adapted for its maturity zone and has excellent stress tolerance

S18-Y3 Brand Added Trait: Roundup Ready Relative Maturity: I-8

- High-yielding with exceptional drought stress tolerance, plus excellent PRR field tolerance with the Rps1k gene
- This medium height, medium bushy plant is best suited to 30" and narrower rows and soils
 where IDC is not a concern

S23-N7 Brand Added Traits: Roundup Ready and SCN Relative Maturity: II-3

- Strong Race 3 and 14 SCN protection, above average BSR tolerance and excellent white mold tolerance; avoid IDC areas
- This medium-tall, medium bush plant is well-suited for central areas from eastern Wisconsin and Indiana west through Minnesota and Iowa and is best suited to soils where IDC is not a concern

 Best in class for yield, consistency and disease tolerance with Race 3 and 14 SCN protection, very good PRR field tolerance with the Rps1k gene, industry-leading sudden death syndrome (SDS) tolerance and excellent white mold tolerance With excellent standability, it is best suited to soils where IDC is not a concern

S30-F5 Brand Added Traits: Roundup Ready and SCN Relative Maturity: III-0

- Excellent yields and industry-leading SDS tolerance, Race 3 and 14 SCN protection and very good PRR field tolerance
