Yield and drought tolerance for the early market

Days to Mid-Bloom: 62

Maturity: Med-Early

- Medium-early harvest, medium-tall height, open head, red hybrid with excellent grain quality
- · Very uniform with excellent stalk quality
- Matures a little later the farther north it goes
- · Works equally well in dryland and irrigated fields
- Small and hard-seeded

Standability and performance make this the top choice for all yield environments

Days to Mid-Bloom: 68

Maturity: Med-Full

- Harvest timing is not critical due to superior standability
- Excellent early vigor means planting date can be pushed
- Rugged hybrid that canopies well under all environmental condtions
- Standability is second to none due to excellent stalk quality and strength
- Post-flower stress may cause less exertion

Widely adapted, yield leader for the mid to late market

Days to Mid-Bloom: 67

Maturity: Med-Full Day

- Medium-late harvest, medium height, semi-open head, red hybrid
- Consistent yield across all environments
- Tremendous disease package to go along with top-end yield
- Not recommended for the upper coast of Texas

Widely adapted, medium maturity yield leader

Days to Mid-Bloom: 65

Maturity: Medium

- Medium harvest, medium-tall height, semi-open head, bronze hybrid with excellent stress tolerance
- Very good weathering
- Takes advantage of late-season moisture to increase yield
- · Excellent standability on all soil types

Full-season yield leader with outstanding weathering

Days to Mid-Bloom: 73

Maturity: Full

- Late harvest, tall height, semi-closed head, red hybrid with unique ability to be used as grain or forage
- Outstanding exertion and head type give this hybrid a unique field appearance
- · Outstanding weathering
- Excellent stress tolerance
- Best suited for far south Texas and Mexico

Downy mildew resistance with top-end yields

Days to Mid-Bloom: 71

Maturity: Full

- Late harvest, tall height, open-headed, bronze hybrid with excellent top-end yield potential
- Downy mildew resistance
- Best if kept in its maturity zone but could also move north
- Average stress tolerance, exertion will decrease under stress
- Best suited for far south Texas and Mexico
